loss of the trade of pilgrims, as there was a sharp decline in European pilgrims. [8] William IV, Count of Nevers had promised the Christian bishops of Bethlehem that if Bethlehem fell under Muslim control, he would receive them in the small town of Clamecy in the current Burgundy, France. As a result, the bishop of Bethlehem was duly
accommodated in the hospital of Panthenor, Clamecy, in 1223.
